Ponytail

Start by pulling your dancer's hair into a tight ponytail. A <u>bristle brush</u> and wax stick Is helpful for creating a smooth, finished look.



Tame Flyaways

Use water, <u>gel</u>, or <u>hairspray</u> to make sure all hair stays in place. High ponytails/buns should not have a part. Low ponytails/buns should be parted in the middle of the head.



For a Ballet Bun: Twist and Wrap

Twist hair and wrap It into a bun. For thick hair, you may want to do this in 2 sections. Pin as you go to make sure the hair is tightly secured!



Hair Pins/Hair Net

The trick to a secure ballet bun is <u>hair pins</u> and a hair net. Follow this link for recommendations to match a variety of hair colors.

Performance Ready!

If your dancer's costume includes a hairpiece, make sure to <u>bobby pin</u> it into their hair so it doesn't fall out during their performance.
